Brussels, 1 April 2026 - JARVIS, a four-year project funded under the Horizon Europe Programme and dedicated to advancing human-robot collaboration, announces the launch of its second Open Call. With this new call, introduces two distinct funding tracks, *Co-Development* and *External Pilots*, designed to support both technology development and real-world deployment. The initiative invites startups, SMEs, research organisations, and industry stakeholders to contribute to the next generation of collaborative robotics solutions. In total, the Open Call will support up to 13 projects, including:

- 8 projects under the *Co-Development Track* (up to €100,000 each), and
- 5 pilots under the *External Pilots Track* (up to €130,000 each).

FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES FOR INNOVATORS

Open Call 2 is structured around two tracks.

1. Co-Development Track (For Tech Innovators)

This track focuses on enhancing the JARVIS framework through the development of modular human-robot interaction (HRI) technologies. Selected projects will validate advanced collaborative robotics components up to TRL6 and support their integration into real industrial environments.

- Funding: up to **€100,000** per project (*8 projects in total*)
- Deadline: 1 June, 2026
- Consortia: 2 organisations
- Duration: 9 months

2. External Pilots Track (For Industry & Use Cases)

This track supports the development and real-world validation of innovative solutions demonstrating the scalability and replicability of JARVIS technologies across new sectors and applications.

- Funding: up to **€130,000** per project (*5 projects in total*)
- Deadline: 10 July, 2026
- Consortia: 2-3 organisations
- Duration: 10 months

- Technical mentoring and guidance
- Access to the JARVIS ecosystem, tools, and pilot environments
- Real-world testing and validation opportunities
- Visibility and promotion through the JARVIS network

- Address a topic or challenge outlined in the Open Call documents
- Include all required annexes in PDF format
- Be written in English
